


## **Keyword Sentence Drill**

## <u>Instructions</u>

3. There is also a sentence for the student to practice hearing the short vowel sounds in a sentence. The sentence is, "Sad Ed is not up." (It contains all the short vowel sounds.) Ask the student to read the sentence slowly, stretching out the vowel sounds. The purpose of this sentence is to train the brain to "hear" (by which I really mean process and build the neural pathways) the short vowel sounds. Have the student practice this sentence 2 times in a row.
